Furthermore, some cities have

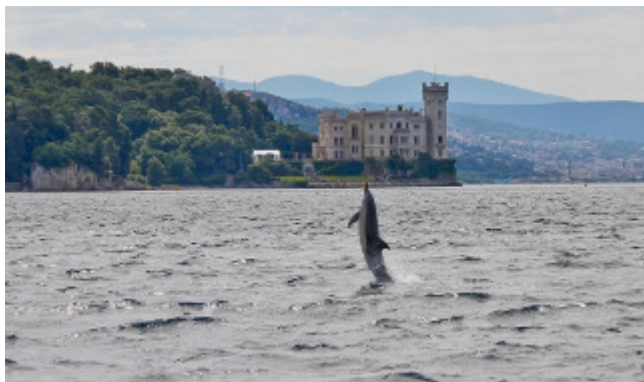
- Interest in the conservation of Cetaceans and Sea Turtles
